King's Coronation Celebration

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you already know, next weekend it is the King's Coronation and we are looking forward to celebrating this historic event with our children in school. Following our previous letter, please see below for further details.

Tuesday 2nd May - 'Coronation Cake-Off'.

- There will be three categories; cupcakes, biscuits and sponge cakes with a first place and runner up prize in each category.
- If baking biscuits or cupcakes, we are asking that only 6 are sent into school, as we are anticipating a lot of entries!
- Cakes/biscuits should be sent into school on Tuesday morning in a labelled airtight container (so all containers can be returned following the event) As cakes will be kept in school overnight, we want to ensure they are all kept fresh.
- Please ensure all cakes are NUT FREE
- Cakes and biscuits will be sold for a donation on Wednesday at the coronation picnic. Money raised will be used to support curriculum activities and also to support our chosen charity, Chorley Hedgehog Rescue.

Wednesday 3rd May – Coronation Picnic

- Children and parents are all invited to wear red, white and blue.
- Gates will open at 11.45am as parents and guests are welcomed onto the KS2 playground.
- Guests are to bring a picnic blanket/chairs, food and drink to be enjoyed outside with your child/ren on the school playground and field.
- The event will begin at 12pm with a whole school singing performance of the National Anthem
- Cakes will be on sale and we are asking for small cash donations.
- All classes will be involved in a singing performance.
- The winners and runners up of the Coronation Cake Off will be announced and prizes awarded

Please note, in the case of bad weather the event will be cancelled. Parents will be notified via Class Dojo (My School Story) by 10.30am. Fingers crossed, the weather is kind as we are looking forward to an exciting whole school celebration!
